

COREO Medications Display Quick Reference Guide

1. When viewing the total count of Medications that a patient has been prescribed within the Clinical tab, filter by the 'Category' view.
2. Select 'Medications' from the event drop down.
 - The total count in the category header will show ONLY the amount of active medications (This example is 0)
 - BUT the total number of rows will show the amount of active and *inactive* medications (This example is 5)

3. Once you select 'Medications', sub categories will display for 'Show Inactive Meds' and 'Show Unique Value'. 'Show Inactive Meds' will be selected by default.
4. In order to view ONLY the active medications, unselect the 'Show Inactive Meds' checkbox. Now, the total rows will match the total count in the category header. (This example is 0)
